For the students aged 15-17

Objectives: Speaking: description of Romeo and Juliet, sharing the impressions;

Listening for the main idea and specific information;

Vocabulary related to Shakespearean writing;

Grammar: Present and Past Simple Passive.

Equipment: interactive whiteboard software, printed tasks.

Script of the lesson

Hello! Let's begin. In April a lot of celebrities were born. Now you have to guess the person whose literary masterpiece we are going to work with. Pay attention to the list of adjectives given on the board. They characterize his written works.

Let's say them together:

If you arrange the first letters into the line you will read the surname of one the greatest masters in the world of literature.

Of course you are right, his name is William Shakespeare. So the theme of our lesson is:

2. What is his birth place?
3. What do you know about his family?
4. What is William Shakespeare famous for?
5. What plays written by William Shakespeare do you know?
6. What famous quotations from the works of Shakespeare can you remember?

PRE-TASK (before watching)

Define the words from the hat (the words are printed on sheets of paper and put into the hat).


Students take the sheets and give the definitions of the words.

The students get acquainted with the video provided by the British Council. Then they are encouraged to share their impressions after watching.

The stops are made after each part in order to complete the tasks. After the completion of each task the teacher shows the keys to check the answers and give the comments where necessary.
